- The Pain Point Connection: Think about a specific area of suffering or injustice in the world that truly breaks your heart (e.g., loneliness, lack of education, environmental damage, divisiveness). How do your specific God-gifts intersect with that pain point? Write a plan detailing how you could use your unique skills—not someone else's—to offer a specific solution, even if it's small, consistent action.
- Healing Through Creation: If you could create one thing (a book, a piece of art, a non-profit, a conversation space, a new policy) using your most powerful gift, and you knew it would instantly bring healing, peace, or understanding to a difficult situation, what would it be? Describe this creation in detail. What is the very first tiny step you can take today to start gathering materials or knowledge for this ultimate creation?
- The Shadow of Your Gift: Often, our greatest strengths come with corresponding weaknesses or fears that keep them hidden. What fear (e.g., fear of failure, fear of judgment, fear of commitment) is currently preventing you from using your most impactful gift to its fullest potential for global good? Write a commitment to God to overcome that specific barrier, detailing the practical accountability step you will take this week to push past it.
- A Week of Intentional Service: Design a seven-day experiment where you consciously and publicly use one of your key God-gifts (e.g., your voice, your hands, your insight) every single day to bring a measure of healing to someone or something around you. Journal about the interaction each day, noting how it felt to give the gift, and what unexpected healing or joy you received in return.
